Dear Sheep Applicant,

We have just finished our best Sheep season ever! The weather this year was tough but everyone was patient and physically ready to go once the weather broke. We really got to put our gear to the test and see why it is important to have good quality gear when hunting in Alaska.

We had 4 hunters draw the coveted TOK Management Area sheep tags. Those hunters all took great rams with 3 going over 40" and the other being an 11 year old double broomed bruiser. The TOK once again provided us with opportunities to glass many legal rams and be selective in the rams that we harvested.

We had two rifle hunters and one archery hunter draw Chugach 14C tags. Both rifle hunters harvested old heavies. The first being a 12-year-old 38" ram and the other an 11 year old with both sides just hitting 40". Our archery hunter had by far the worst weather of the season, many days the wind never got below 40 mph. Even with the rough weather we were able to get close enough to have multiple shot opportunities but with only busted arrows to show for it.

We are already excited and looking forward to the 2007 sheep season. It is becoming more and more evident that the best opportunities in Alaska to harvest a trophy ram are in the limited draw areas. We have recognized the decline in most general areas and have put our energy almost exclusively into hunting TOK and 14C limited area sheep hunts. The limited number of hunters allows rams to reach their full potential.

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game has implemented some changes for this years drawing application. Before a non-resident, that does not have a second-degree of kindred living in Alaska can apply in the TOK, he must first have a signed agreement with a TOK licensed registered guide. I have enclosed a Limited Draw Area Application for you to fill out and return to us, which will meet this requirement. We will then apply for your desired hunts or the hunts that we feel will best suit you, whichever you prefer.

Our 9-day sheep hunts are \$10,500 with us providing a shuttle from the Anchorage Airport to your hunt area. Once you have harvested a ram we will help you get it checked into Fish & Game along with helping make all arrangements for you to get your meat, cape, and horns to your desired locations.

Our guides here at Freelance Outdoor Adventures are very knowledgeable in sheep habits and behavior. They are young, experienced, and ready to do whatever it takes to get you your ram. They all possess the latest in equipment making field judging, packing, and just living with the sheep much more comfortable. Each hunter has 1 guide and 1 packer so that they have every possible advantage once they reach sheep country. For our guides, sheep hunting is not a job, it's an obsession!
